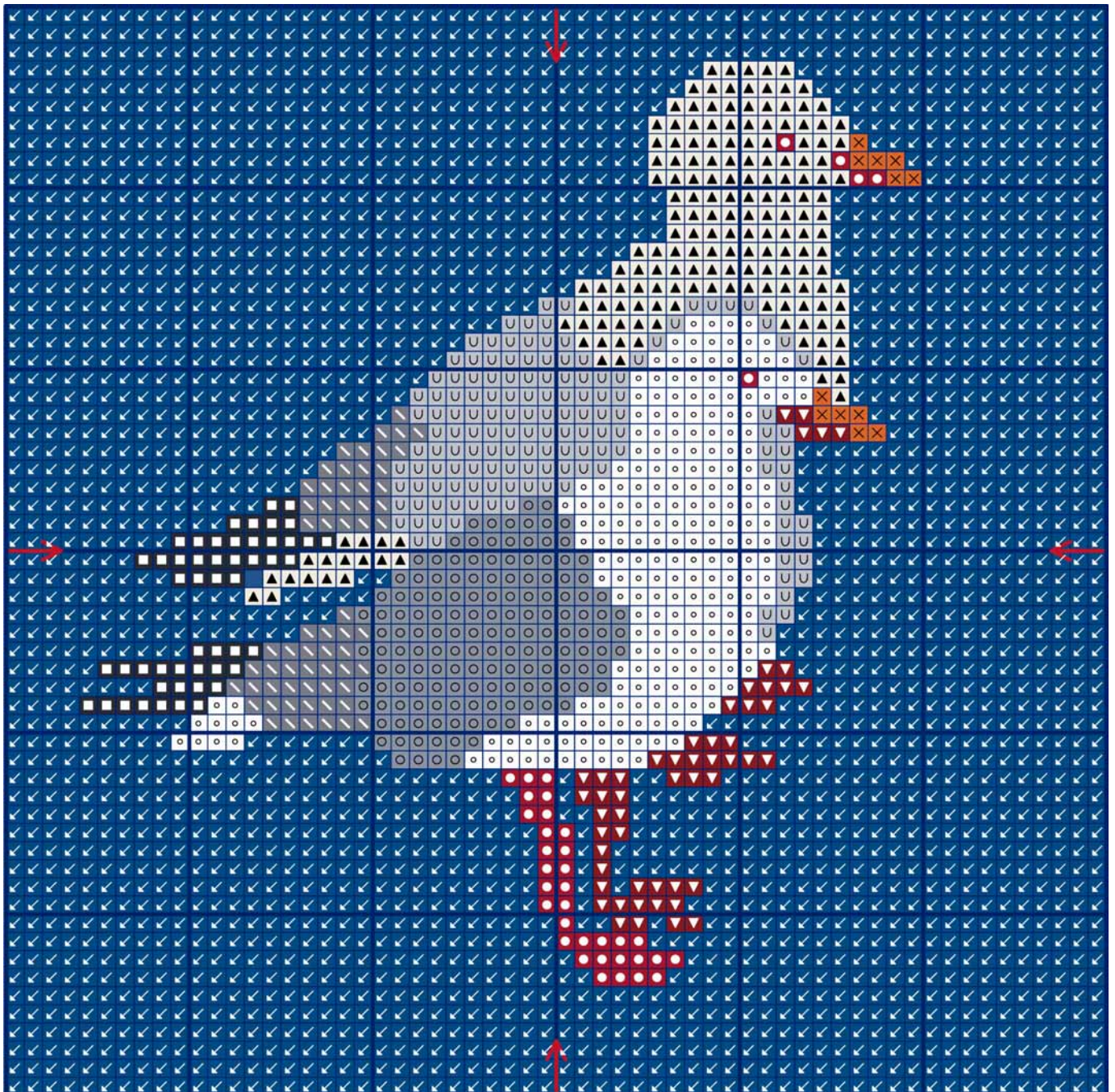
Latch Hook Cushion

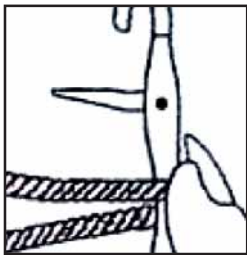

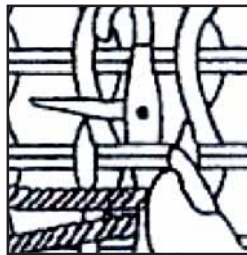

General Instructions:-

The design is shown in chart form with colour key symbols. Firstly ensure that the size of your canvas is sufficient for your design by checking the number of stitches required in each direction. The Canvas should be large enough to allow you start on one of the grid lines (this makes counting your pattern easier). There should be at least six lines of canvas left outside the design unless you are starting near a selvedge edge, where you may work right up to the selvedge. Each coloured square on the chart represents one knot. Starting with the canvas facing you with the twisted thread running vertically and the parallel thread across, turn your pattern to match the canvas. Begin stitching completing one row at a time following the chart. Work in one direction only and do not work ahead of yourself.



Fold one piece of yarn in half around shank of hook below latch.



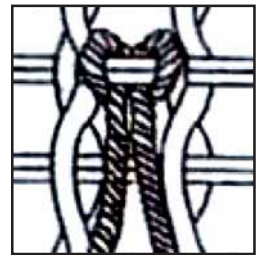
Insert tip of hook into one hole out of hole directly above so that hook latch are on the top side.



Take both ends of yarn place between hook and latch.



Still holding yarn ends pull hook towards you, releasing ends as the hook pulls through loop.



Tighten knot by pulling ends towards you evenly.

Finishing Instructions:-

When your design is completed you need to turn under the excess canvas and using a needle and strong thread attach securely to the underside of your design. Make sure that you sew over a number of threads so the canvas can not unravel.
