Instructions:

- Use 2 strands for all stitching.
- 1 square on the graph equals one Aida square.
- Stitch symbols as Cross stitch or 3/4 Cross stitch.
- Stitch lines as Back stitch with 3021.
- Stitch eye pupil as a French knot.

Yellow-eyed Penguin - *Megadyptes antipodes* Maori name: *Hoihoi*

Standing about 65cm and weighing around 5-6 kilograms, the Yellow-eyed or Hoihoi penguin is known as the noisy one.


They are easily identified by the distinctive yellow eye and bright yellow stripe that runs through the eye and around the back of the head. Both sexes are alike, although the male does have slightly larger head and feet.

One of the rarest of our penguins and listed by the Department of Conservation as "Threatened", the Yellow-eyed penguins breed in coastal scrub from Banks Peninsula to Campbell Island and Auckland islands.




